Call for Papers Developing Academic Practice special issue on AI in Learning and Teaching

<u>Developing Academic Practice</u> (DAP) is a gold open access Academy journal supported by Liverpool University Press aiming to celebrate scholarship in all aspects of academic practice in Higher Education.

- Digital education/AI-enhanced learning and developing staff and student digital literacies;
- Values, ethics and critiques of education practice regarding AI;
- Learning and teaching philosophies in education in regard to AI in academic practice;
- Policy development and academic practice in higher education related to AI.

The Editors welcome submissions which can take one of the following formats:

- Research papers: up to 5,000 words, excluding references;
- Case studies: up to 2,000 words, excluding references;
- Reflections on practice up to 1,000 words, excluding references;
- Lightning AI solutions accompanied by an appropriate AI-generated image: <u>one page, sample</u> here.
- Other formats will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Deadlines for submission

- Expression of interest/abstract up to 250 words: 1st November 2024
- Full paper submitted before 27th January 2025
- Feedback from reviewers 18th May 2025
- Authors resubmit paper 30th September 2025
