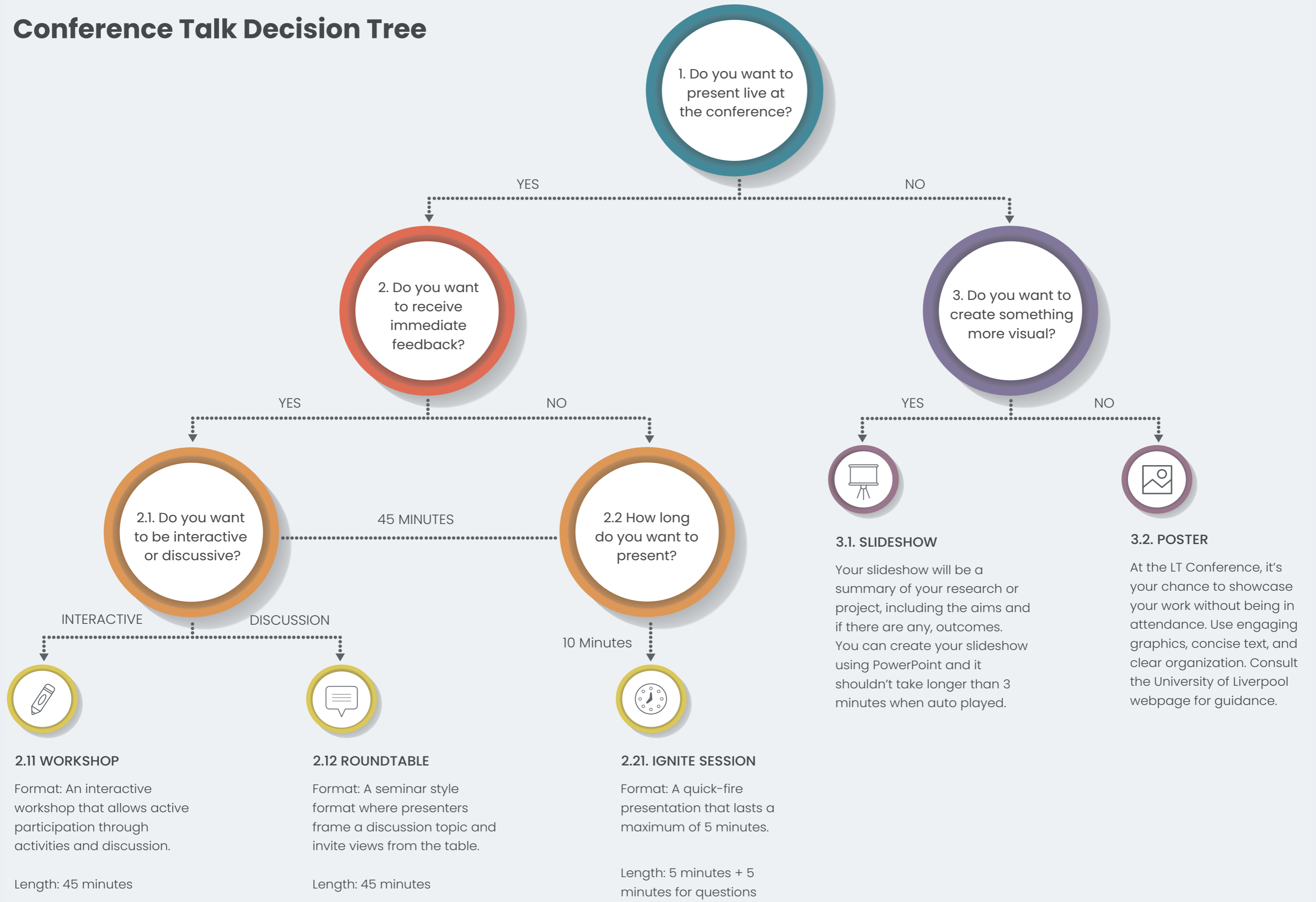


Conference Talk Decision Tree



Process Description

1. Do you want to present live at the conference?

- If yes, proceed to step 2
 - If no, proceed to step 3

2. Do you want to receive immediate feedback?

- If yes, proceed to step 2.1
 - If no, proceed to step 2.2
-

2.1 Do you want to be interactive or discussive?

- If Interactive, proceed to step 2.11 – Workshop Format: An interactive workshop that allows active participation through activities and discussion.

Length: 45 minutes

- If Discussive, proceed to step 2.12 – Roundtable Format: A seminar style format where presenters frame a discussion topic and invite views from the table.

Length: 45 minutes

3. Do you want to create something more visual?

- If yes, proceed to step 3.1 – Slideshow
Your slideshow will be a summary of your research or project, including the aims and if there are any, outcomes. You can create your slideshow using PowerPoint and it shouldn't take longer than 3 minutes when auto played.

- If no, proceed to step 3.2 – Poster
At the LT Conference, it's your chance to showcase your work without being in attendance. Use engaging graphics, concise text, and clear organization. Consult the University of Liverpool webpage for guidance.

2.2 How long do you want to present?

- If 45 Minutes, proceed to step 2.1
- If 10 Minutes, proceed to step 2.21 – Ignite Session Format: A quick-fire presentation that lasts a maximum of 5 minutes.

Length: 5 minutes + 5 minutes for questions
