

School of Medicine: Admission Requirements

A100: Guidelines for applicants offering an honours degree

The <u>University of Liverpool</u> requires a GAMSAT result as part of the entry requirements for graduates applying for the 5 year programme (A100).

Minimum Requirements Usually:

Academic:

- Minimum 2:1 Honours degree in any degree subject (or a predicted upper second-class degree or above if you are on or about to enter the final year of your degree programme). Alternatively, a minimum 2:2 degree in any subject <u>plus</u> Masters/PhD higher qualification.
- A minimum of 50 in each sub-component of the GAMSAT entrance exam. <u>http://gamsat.acer.edu.au/gamsat-uk</u> Entry is competitive and achieving the minimum GAMSAT score may be insufficient to secure an interview.
- Dental graduates applying to the OMFS route should apply to the A101 programme. Details at Admissions information - School of Medicine - University of Liverpool

Other attributes:

Evidence of appropriate experience and aptitude:

- Candidates must demonstrate suitable evidence of:
- health care career awareness/insight.
- a critical, coherent, and informative approach to communication.
- the values that embody and underpin good healthcare practice.

Please note:

- Applicants **must** read our Departmental Supplement to the Admissions Policy- A100 programme where details of the selection process for graduates applying to A100 are outlined
- Applications made through UCAS in the normal way. An **additional on-line form** will need to be completed by certain groups of applicants. Please refer to www.liverpool.ac.uk/medicine/study-with-us/undergraduate/admissions-information/
- Home graduates usually apply to the A101 graduate entry programme. International graduates are eligible to apply to A100 only.

Applicants are advised to consider the financial implications prior to placing an application.
- The above indicative criteria are the usual **minimum** required. Entry is competitive and meeting minimum academic and non-academic requirements does not guarantee that you will receive an offer of an interview or place on the programme.
- If an applicant fails to achieve a place on the A100 programme they may only make one further consecutive application to the programme.
- Applicants are advised to complete the application fully and to leave no gaps in educational and employment history. The School reserves the right to reject an application on the basis of insufficient information where applicable, to request additional information if necessary, and to use any relevant information available to them in making borderline decisions.
