

- If you **cannot find your university** when you search for it and are from a partner institution, please try another format as all partner universities should be listed. Otherwise, please select ‘Other’.
- You do not need to upload a **transcript** with your ISS application if you do not have one. If you cannot move forwards with the application without uploading a document, please upload proof of your current grades or enrolment at your university.
- In order to participate in the ISS you need to fit into one of the following **English Language** categories:
 - Be a native speaker of English
 - Have an English language test stating your ability. Please see the tests accepted [here](#).
 - Have our letter template filled in by your home university, confirming that you are able to speak English to CEFR B2 standard. If you need this, you can request via email at iss@liverpool.ac.uk.
- You do not need to provide anything in the ‘**Supporting Information**’ or ‘**References**’ sections.
- Please ensure you read the terms and conditions before ticking yes to confirm. You can then check your application, digitally sign it, and submit! We will check your details after you have completed Stage 1, and you will then receive an email prompting you to register for Mobility Online (Stage 2).
